Eligibility requirements:

Undergraduate Student

1. Junior or Senior Status in Civil Engineering
2. Pursuing technical electives in Structural Engineering, Construction, and/or Construction Management
3. Full or part time student in good standing at U T Arlington.
4. Completed at least 12 hours in engineering classes with minimum GPA of 3.0
5. Permanent residence in Dallas County, Tarrant County, or adjoining counties.

Masters Degree Student

1. Full or part time student in good standing at U T Arlington
2. Majoring in CE area of Construction Engineering / Construction Management
3. Graduate GPA 3.0
4. Permanent residence in Dallas County, Tarrant County, or adjoining counties

Award Amount

The minimum amount to be awarded is \$500.00. The maximum amount to be awarded is \$1,000.00.

Disbursement of Scholarship

Prior to the first semester after the award is granted, half the proceeds are disbursed. The remainder of the award is to be presented prior to the start of the next semester, conditional on the successful completion of the first semester's work.
